

# **Post Expedition Report**

## **Ernest Shackleton's trek across**

### **Trip Code A04/19**

**Led by Bernd Adler from 02.11. – 11.11.2013**

**Our first plan was to cross the island on the Shackleton route but for use was this not possible. Because we have sent a part of our luggage, before the expedition, with DHL to Falkland Island. This part of our luggage was disappeared and did not show up again. So without tents and sleeping bags was for use not possible to start the expedition on the Shackleton route. We decided that we come to South Georgia for daily ski trips and that we use our sailing ship Santa Maria Australis as a base. During our ten days had we the most of this time bad weather and strong wind. So we could do only three trips with ski. We had to wait for better weather on the sailing ship for the rest of the time.**

**Monday 04.11.2013**

**From Gold Harbour on the Bertrab Glacier to the summit and the same way back. Coordinates and Altitude from the summit:  
S 54° 40. 000' / W 36° 00. 000' – 920 MaS (Meters above Sea)**

**Friday 08.11.2013**

**From Fortuna Bay on the Fortuna Glacier to the summit and the same way back. Coordinates and Altitude from the summit:  
S 54° 11. 280' / W 36° 52. 390' – 950 MaS**

**Sunday 10.11.2013**

**From Sunset Fjord on the Brunonia Glacier to the summit and the same way back. Coordinates and Altitude from the summit:  
S 54° 03. 900' / W 37° 32. 250' – 651 MaS**
